

ECONOMIC IMPACT

As the state's largest employer, Sanford's economic activity supported more than **26,200 jobs** and **\$1.7 billion** in wages and compensation for North Dakotans in 2020.

Our combined economic activity added nearly **\$2.3 billion** to North Dakota's GDP and contributed **\$4.3 billion** to the economy (4% of the state's total GDP).

Over the past four years, Sanford's construction in North Dakota supported an annual average of **400 jobs** and **\$29.1 million** in compensation. This construction contributed an average of **\$68.1 million** to the economy each year.

This study was conducted utilizing IMPLAN, a nationally recognized economic impact modeling system based on 2019 data to calculate the 2020 impact from Sanford operations in North Dakota, South Dakota, Minnesota and Iowa. The methodology estimates economic relationships between industries, households and government.
